This is an OPEN Horse Show - All Breeds Welcome.

Show to will judged according to AQHA rules.

Approved helmets REQUIRED in ALL 'OVER FENCES' CLASSES! Helmets are allowed in all classes and rider will not be discriminated against for wearing a helmet.

Competitors in speed events are REQUIRED to wear appropriate western clothing, including long sleeve shirt. If approved helmet is not worn, a cowboy hat is REQUIRED in speed events. Stampede strings are encouraged.

Rookie classes (underlined) are for beginning riders or horses. Riders entering these classes will be placed. Riders showing above this level MAY enter rookie class as a schooling class but will not be placed. Rookie classes are NOT AQHA approved rookie classes.

Small Fry 10 & under classes: Rider entered in small fry class in any event may NOT enter a youth class in the same event. However, rider may enter small fry in one event and a regular youth class in another event or events.

Adult Classes – 19 & Over

Youth Classes – 18 & Under (as of January 1st, 2014)

AQHA entries may show for AQHA points in most classes. Classes that may count for AQHA points are followed by a + sign.
* AQHA weanlings may show ONLY as OPEN entry. Weanlings will not be eligible to show as AQHA entries.

AQHA Entries Only, please note: Classes listed as 'adult' classes will run as AQHA Amateur classes concurrently. Professionals showing in any of these classes will only be able to enter as non-AQHA entries. Professionals MAY enter any junior or senior horse class or class listed as 'open' as AQHA entry, however. Classes listed as Youth and Open classes will have corresponding AQHA youth or AQHA open class to run concurrently. Awards and Ribbons will ONLY be awarded in the OPEN Show classes. Grand and Reserve AQHA halter champions will be designated if not the same horses as Open Show Grand or Reserve Champions. AQHA Grand and Reserve winners will receive ribbons only if they do NOT stand Grand or Reserve in the Open Show.

All entries showing as AQHA entries must follow AQHA rules as to ownership or lease of horse and **must** be current AQHA member. Memberships may be obtained at entry booth on show day. If showing as AQHA entry, you **must** bring original AQHA registration papers on your horse to the show office to register for your classes.
